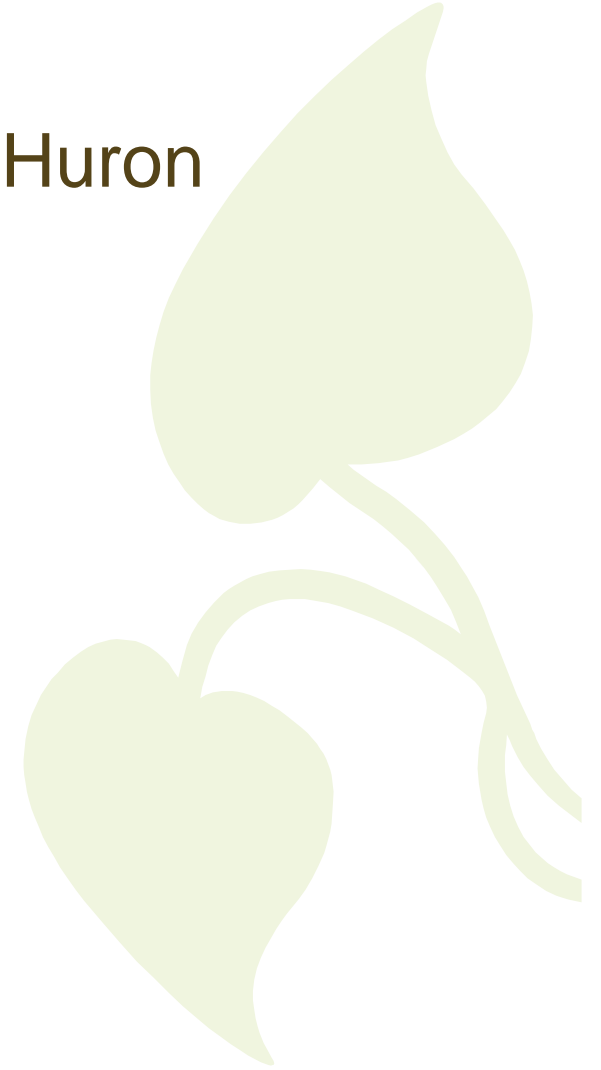


# 6 Delegates per District

- District 2 – Bruce & Huron
- District 3 – Perth, Waterloo, Wellington & all other counties not included in districts 1 & 2
  - (at least 2 of the 6 are to be growers from Simcoe or York or in any of the geographic areas located to the east or north.

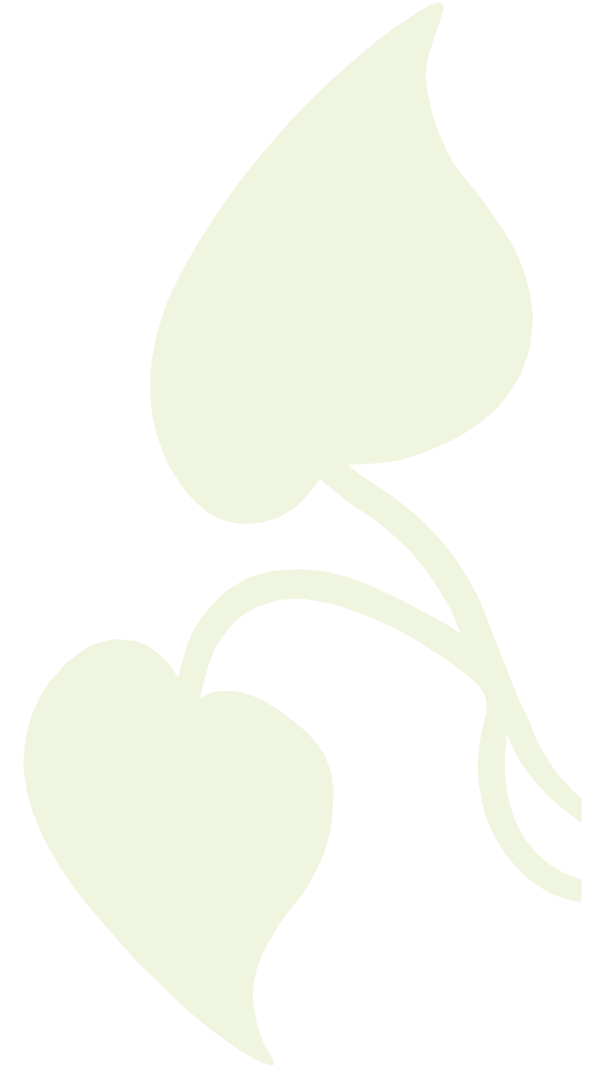
# 3 Meetings Per Year

- Annual Meeting in February



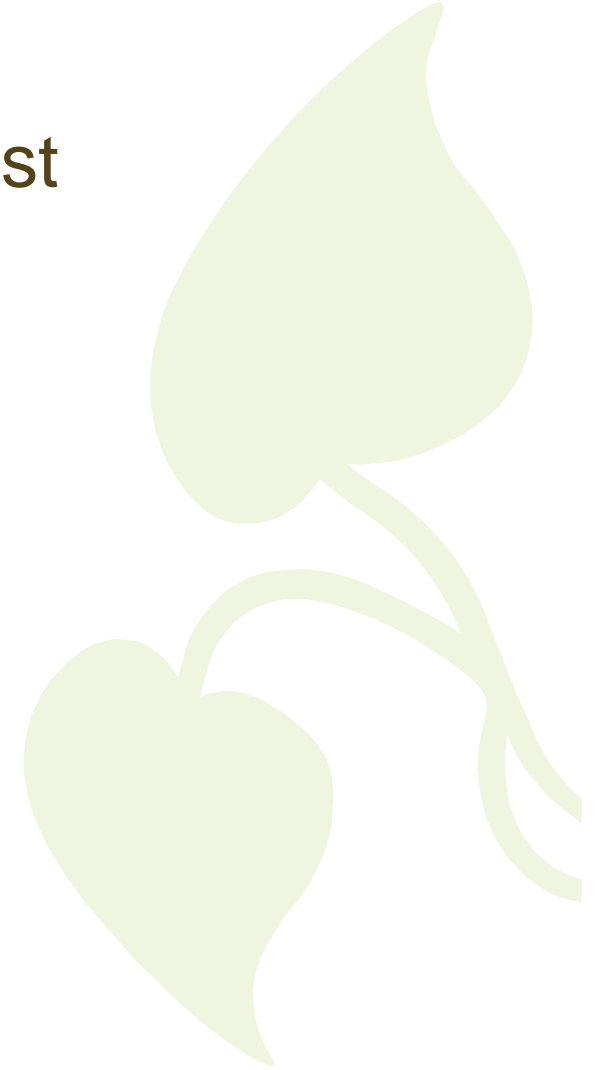
# Volunteer for a Committee
